Terms and Conditions of Entry

- The exhibitors will either live or work in Waltham Forest.
- A maximum of 1 artwork and/or 3 poems can be submitted.
- 3. The fees are:

For an artwork: £10 – or £5 (for unemployed or low-waged).



The *Inspired!* exhibition will be at The Mill from 30 May to 19 July - as part of the 2019 E17 Art Trail.

There will be a celebratory "Meet the Artists" breakfast 11am-1pm on Sunday 7 July.

For poems: £10 - or £5 (for unemployed or low waged) for <u>one</u> poem. £5 each for second or third poem (no reduced rate).

Payment must be submitted in cash when entries are handed in.

Receipt for payment – please ensure you are given a copy of your completed Entry Form - <u>after</u> details have been added in the 'For Office Use Only' box by a Mill member of staff or volunteer - to confirm your submission and payment made.

- 4. The Mill's Art Works team will be responsible for the selection and hanging of works and only exhibitors who are <u>not</u> accepted will be contacted (and offered a refund).
- 5. A signed entry form see page 1 stating agreement to these terms and conditions, and including contact details, must be submitted with all entries.
- 6. Submission dates all work must be handed in to The Mill, 7 11 Coppermill Lane, E17, on one of the following four dates:

Thursday 16 May <u>or</u> Friday 17 May - between 9.30am-6pm Saturday 18 May <u>or</u> Sunday 19 May - between 10am-2pm

- 7. Works may be for sale and prices should include 20% commission, payable to the Mill.
- 8. All work must be labelled at the back, with the artist's name, contact details and title of piece.
- Work should be ready to hang with string attached.
 The maximum <u>size</u> is 50x70cm and maximum <u>weight</u> is 2kg (although this is negotiable)

Please note – clip-frames are not acceptable

- 10. Exhibits will not be insured by The Mill. It is recommended that those with any concerns take out their own insurance.
- 11. All personal details provided by exhibitors will be used only by The Mill's Art Works team and will not be shared with any third party unless the exhibitor has given permission eg for inclusion in the exhibition catalogue.
- 12. Exhibitors who would prefer images of their work NOT to appear on The Mill's website and other social media should indicate this on the Entry form on p.1
- 13. Collection date works are to be collected from The Mill on:

Saturday 20 <u>or</u> Sunday 21 July – 10am-2pm

If you are not able to collect on those dates, please email mo@themille17.org to agree another date, which must be no earlier than 20 July and no later than Sunday 28 July. The Mill does not have space to store uncollected works. Any work not collected by an agreed date will be disposed of.
