# **Terms and Conditions of Entry**

- 1. The exhibitors will either live or work in Waltham Forest.
- 2. A maximum of 3 artworks can be submitted.
- **3.** The fees are:

**Per artwork:** £10 – or £5 (for unemployed or low-waged). *Payment must be submitted in cash when entries are handed in*.

Receipt for payment – please ensure you are given a copy of your completed Entry Form - <u>after</u> details have been added in the 'For Office Use Only' box by a Mill member of staff or volunteer - to confirm your submission and payment made.

- **4.** The Mill's Art Works team will be responsible for the selection and hanging of works and only exhibitors who are <u>not</u> accepted will be contacted (and offered a refund).
- 5. A signed entry form see page 1 stating agreement to these terms and conditions, and including contact details, must be submitted with all entries.
- 6. Submission dates all work must be handed in to The Mill, 7 11 Coppermill Lane, E17, on:

Thursday 26 <u>or</u> Friday 27 September 2019 - between 9.30am-6pm Saturday 28 <u>or</u> Sunday 29 September 2019 - between 10am-2pm

- 7. Works may be for sale and prices should include 20% commission, payable to the Mill.
- 8. All work must have a label attached giving the artist's name, contact details and title of piece.
- 9. Please present work which is **ready to display** .

  Framed work should be strung across the back. Some textile work can be hung from loops or rings incorporated into the piece if you have any concerns please contact artworks@themille17.org before the hand in dates.

Please note – <u>clip-frames</u> are <u>not</u> acceptable

- **10.** The maximum size is 50x70cm and maximum weight is 2kg (although this is negotiable)
- 11. Exhibits will not be insured by The Mill. It is recommended that those with any concerns take out their own insurance.
- **12.** All personal details provided by exhibitors will be used only by The Mill's Art Works team and will not be shared with any third party unless the exhibitor has given permission eg for inclusion in the exhibition catalogue.
- **13.** Exhibitors who are agreeable to images of their work appearing on The Mill's website and other social media should indicate this on the Entry form on p.1.
- 14. Collection dates works are to be collected from The Mill on:

Saturday 7 <u>or</u> Sunday 8 December – 10am-2pm

If you are not able to collect on those dates, please email <u>artworks@themille17.org</u> to agree another date, which must be no earlier than 7 December and no later than Friday 13 December. *The Mill does not have space to store uncollected works*. *Any work not collected by an agreed date will be disposed of*.
