- 2. A maximum of 3 photographs can be submitted.
- 3. The fees are:

- **4.** The Mill's Art Works team will be responsible for the selection and hanging of photographs and only exhibitors who are <u>not</u> accepted will be contacted (and offered a refund).
- 5. A completed entry form see page 1 stating agreement to these terms and conditions, and including contact details, must be submitted with all entries.
- 6. Submission dates all work must be handed in to The Mill, 7 11 Coppermill Lane, E17 7HA, on one of the following dates:

Wednesday 28 to Friday 30 April, and Saturday 1 May - 10.30am-2.30pm

Wednesday 5 May to Saturday 8 May - 10.30am-2.30pm

- 7. Works may be for sale and prices should include 20% commission, payable to the Mill.
- 8. All work must have a label on the back giving the photographer's name, contact details and title of piece.
- 9. (a) Framed photographs should be ready to hang with string attached.

The maximum <u>size</u> is 50x70cm and maximum <u>weight</u> is 2kg (although this is negotiable – in which case, email <u>artworks@themille17.org</u>)

Please note – clip-frames are not acceptable

- (b) Unframed photographs must be printed on photographic or heavyweight paper
- 10. Exhibits will not be insured by The Mill. It is recommended that those with any concerns take out their own insurance.
- 11. All personal details provided by exhibitors will be used only by The Mill's Art Works team and will not be shared with any third party unless the exhibitor has given permission eg for inclusion in the exhibition catalogue.
- 12. Exhibitors who wish images of their work to be included on The Mill's website and other social media should indicate this on the Entry form on p.1.
- **13.** Collection dates photographs must be collected from The Mill on:

Saturday 26 or Sunday 27 June – 10.30am-2.30pm

If you are not able to collect on those dates, please email artworks@themille17.org to agree another date, which must be no earlier than 26 June and no later than Friday 2 July 2021. The Mill does not have space to store uncollected works. Any work not collected by an agreed date will be disposed of.

EXHIBITION ONLINE

There will be an online version of the exhibition on our website – <u>if</u> you would like any of your photographs included please tick the relevant box on page 1 – and then send an image to <u>artworks@themille17.org</u> with the subject line "Image(s) for online exhibition".

Technical specifications:

- To avoid any pixelation or blurriness, your exhibition's "Feature Image" should be a high quality .jpg or .png file measuring 1920px x 1000px up to a maximum file size of 2MB.
- For images that are taller than they are wide (e.g. are a Portrait aspect), the minimum height of the file should be 570px high.
- For images that are wider than they are tall (e.g. are a Landscape aspect), the minimum width of the file should be 1095px wide.
- For images that have a Square aspect, the file should be a minimum 570px (wide) x 570px (high).
