Terms and Conditions of Entry

- The exhibitors will either live or work in Waltham Forest.
- A maximum of 1 artwork <u>and/or</u> 3 poems can be submitted.

3. The fees are:

For an artwork: £10 – or £5 (for unemployed or low-waged).

The *Freedom* exhibition will be at The Mill as part of the 2021 E17 Art Trail.



It will run from 1 July 2021 to 20 August 2021.

For poems: £10 - or £5 (for unemployed or low waged) for <u>one</u> poem. £5 each for second or third poem (no reduced rate).

Payment must be submitted when entries are handed in – by card (preferred) or in cash.

Receipt for payment – please ensure you are given a copy of your completed Entry Form - <u>after</u> details have been added in the 'For Office Use Only' box by a Mill member of staff or volunteer - to confirm your submission and payment made.

- **4.** The Mill's Art Works team will be responsible for the selection and display of works and only exhibitors who are <u>not</u> accepted will be contacted (and offered a refund).
- 5. A signed entry form see page 1 stating agreement to these terms and conditions, and including contact details, must be submitted with all entries.
- 6. **Submission dates** all work must be handed in to The Mill, 7 11 Coppermill Lane, E17, on one of the following three dates:

Dates: Wednesday 16, Thursday 17 and Friday 18 June and Sunday 20, Wednesday 23, Thursday 24 and Friday 25 June.

Times: 10.30am-2.30-pm

- 7. Works may be for sale and prices should include 20% commission, payable to the Mill.
- 8. All work must be labelled at the back, with the artist's name, contact details and title of piece.
- If works are framed, they should be ready to hang with string attached.
 The maximum <u>size</u> is 50x70cm and maximum <u>weight</u> is 2kg (although this is negotiable)

Please note – clip-frames are not acceptable

- **10.** Poems should be provided as printed copy on high quality paper max size A4.
- **11.** Exhibits will not be insured by The Mill. It is recommended that those with any concerns take out their own insurance.
- **12.** All personal details provided by exhibitors will be used only by The Mill's Art Works team and will not be shared with any third party unless the exhibitor has given permission eg for inclusion in the exhibition catalogue.
- **13.** Exhibitors who are agreeable to images of their work appearing on The Mill's website and other social media should indicate this on the Entry form on p.1.
- **14. Collection dates** will be Saturday 21 August and Sunday 22 August. We will be in touch with all exhibitors by mid-July to confirm exact times on each day.
