- **1.** The exhibitors will either live or work in Waltham Forest.
- 2. A maximum of 3 artworks can be submitted.
- **3.** The fees are:

Per artwork: £10 – or £5 (for unemployed, low-waged or children). Payment must be submitted when entries are handed in – by cash or card.

Receipt for payment – please ensure your completed Entry Form is returned to you, after details have been added in the 'For Office Use Only' box by a Mill member of staff or volunteer. This will be your receipt.

- 4. The Mill's Art Works team will be responsible for the selection and hanging of works and only exhibitors who are not accepted will be contacted (and offered a refund).
- 5. A signed entry form see page 1 stating agreement to these terms and conditions, and including contact details, must be submitted with all entries.
- 6. Submission dates all work must be handed in to The Mill, 7 - 11 Coppermill Lane, E17 on one of the following dates:
 - Tuesday 28 June to Friday 1 July 10am-3pm, and
 - Saturday 2 and Sunday 3 July 2022 – 10am-2pm, and
 - Tuesday 5 July to Friday 8 July 10am-3pm
- 7. Works may be for sale and prices should include 20% commission, payable to the Mill.
- 8. All work must have a label attached to the back giving the artist's name, contact details and title of the work.
- **9.** Work should be ready to hang with string attached.

The maximum <u>size</u> is 50x70cm and maximum <u>weight</u> is 2kg (although this is negotiable - in which case, email artworks@themille17.org)

- **10.** Exhibits will not be insured by The Mill. It is recommended that those with any concerns take out their own insurance.
- 11. All personal details provided by exhibitors will be used only by The Mill's Art Works team and will not be shared with any third party unless the exhibitor has given permission – eg for inclusion in the exhibition catalogue.
- 12. Exhibitors who are agreeable to images of their work appearing on The Mill's website and other social media should indicate this on the Entry form on p.1.
- **13.** Collection dates works are to be collected from The Mill on:
 - Tuesday 6 to Friday 9 Sept 10am-3pm, and ٠

The Mill does not have space to store uncollected works. Any work not collected by an agreed date will be disposed of.
