- **4.** The Mill's Art Works team will be responsible for the selection and hanging of works and only exhibitors who are <u>not</u> accepted will be contacted (and offered a refund).
- 5. A signed entry form see page 1 stating agreement to these terms and conditions, and including contact details, must be submitted with all entries.
- 6. Submission dates all work must be handed in to The Mill, 7 11 Coppermill Lane, E17, on one of the following dates:

Tuesday 21 to Friday 24 May 2024 – 9.30am to 5.30pm Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 May 2024 – 10am to 2pm Tuesday 28 to Friday 31 May 2024 – 9.30am to 5.30pm

- 7. Works may be for sale and prices should include 20% commission, payable to the Mill.
- 8. All work must have a label on the back giving your full name, contact details and title of piece.
- 9. Work should be ready to hang with string attached.

The maximum <u>size</u> is 50x70cm and maximum <u>weight</u> is 2kg (although this is negotiable – in which case, email <u>artworks@themille17.org</u>).

We welcome works in any medium – **but have limited resources for displaying audio-visual or 3D work** – and ask that you please send full details of your work **before submitting** so we can make sure we can display it. If you are submitting a **written work**, please print on A4, high quality paper/card – min 120gsm.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Clip-frames are <u>not</u> acceptable.
- You should ensure that your work is in a bag or other wrapping when you hand in - to ensure it is not damaged during storage. If particularly fragile, use a box and/or bubble wrap.
- 10. Exhibits will not be insured by The Mill. It is recommended that those with any concerns take out their own insurance.
- 11. All personal details provided by exhibitors will be used only by The Mill's Art Works team and will not be shared with any third party unless the exhibitor has given permission eg for inclusion in the exhibition catalogue.
- **12.** Exhibitors who are agreeable to images of their work appearing on The Mill's website and other social media should indicate this on the Entry form on p.1.
- 13. Collection dates works are to be collected from The Mill on:

Tuesday 30 July to Friday 2 August 2024 – between 9.30am to 5.30pm Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 August 2024 – between 10am-2pm

If you are not able to collect on those dates, please email artworks@themille17.org to agree another date, which must be no earlier than Sunday 28 July and, ideally, no later than Sunday 11 August 2024. The Mill does not have space to store uncollected works. Any work not collected by an agreed date will be disposed of.
